

CMI conference, report by Dr. Ed Holroyd, 13 July 2025.

For July 9 to 12, 2025, Creation Ministries International (CMI, website Creation.com) put on a conference “Layers of Faith” in a southwestern suburb of Denver, Colorado, attended by 150 to 200 people coming from many parts of the country. CMI has offices in 7 countries, ultimately based in Brisbane, Australia. The American base is in a suburb of Atlanta. They have published the excellent Creation magazine for decades.

The conference started with a Wednesday morning tour of the nearby Dinosaur Ridge, with its abundant dinosaur footprints and some bone fossils. It was made famous in about 1877 by the first discoveries of bone fossils of Stegosaurus and Apatosaurus. I was stationed as a guide at the bone site and reviewed the discovery history. Additionally I showed that the bone fossils at this site had attracted Uranium from the ground water, making them radioactive. That led to a review of the assumptions involved in radiometric dating. The “closed system” is obviously not valid here because Uranium, the “parent” element arrived later.





Copy of Ichthyosaur (swimming dinosaur) giving birth, showing instantaneous burial, rapid fossilization.




